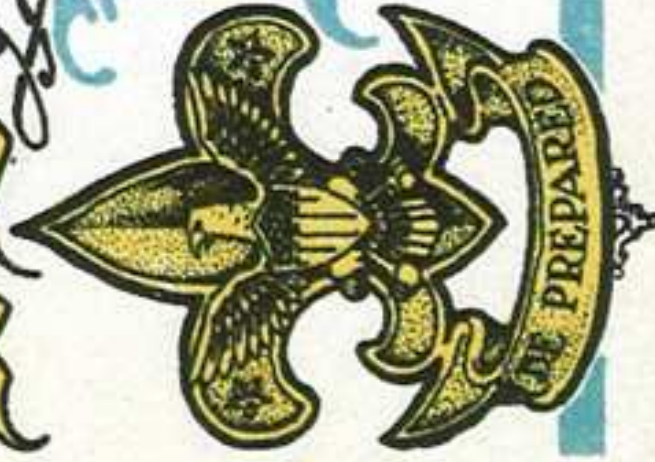

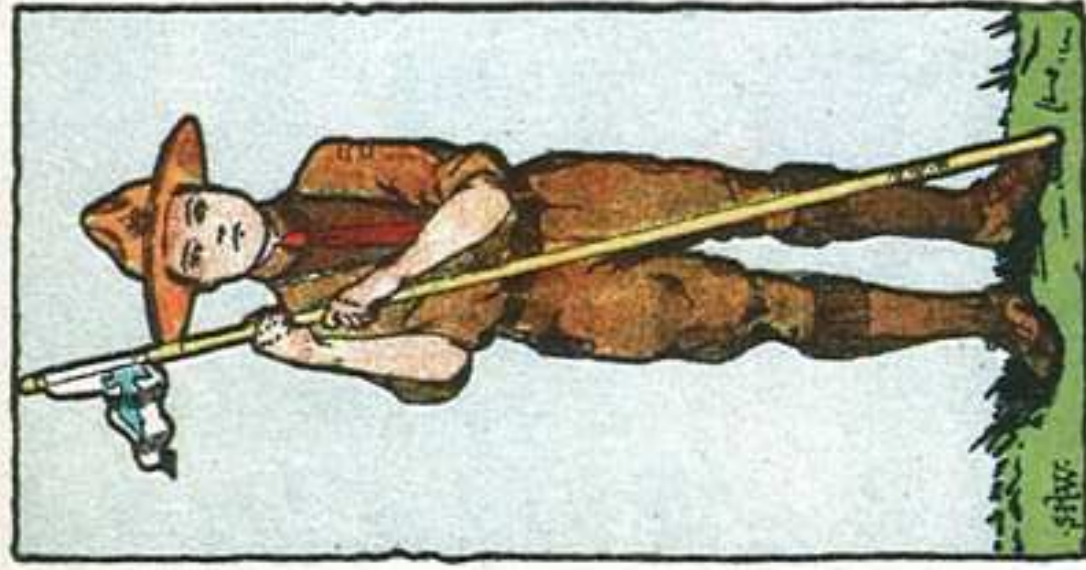

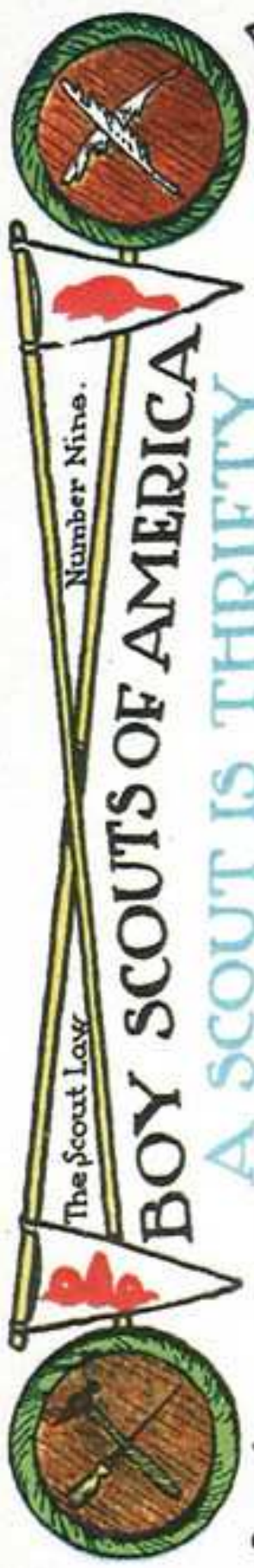
A SCOUT IS CHEERFUL

grumbles at hardships.



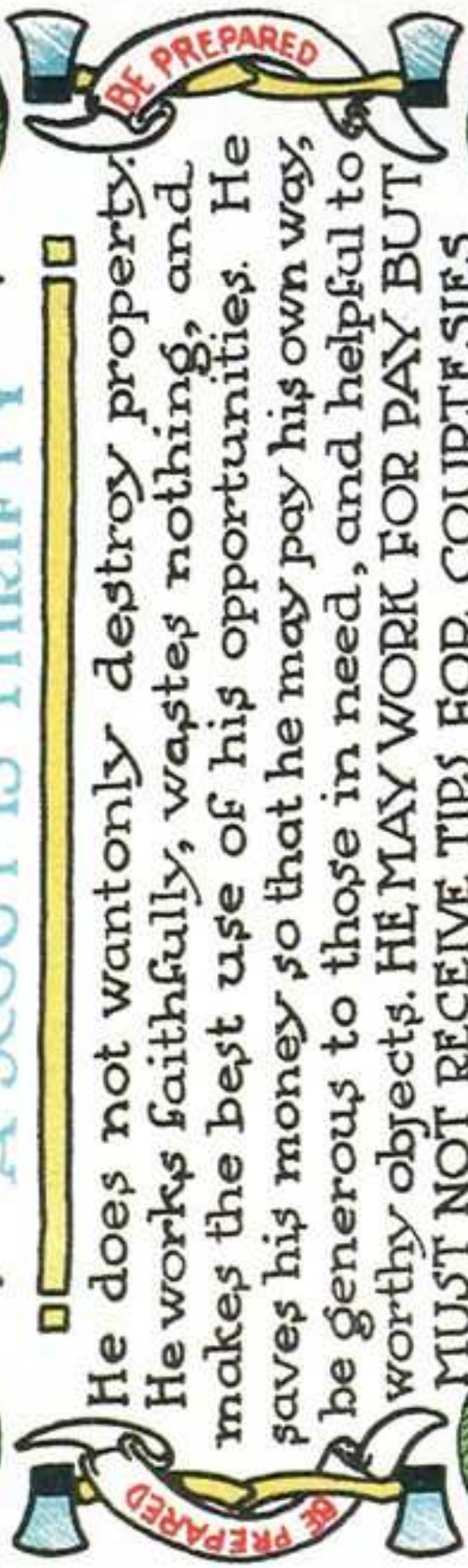
